MEMORANDUM

RE: Changes in Acceptance of Medical Evidence

On June 30, 2005, Judge Janis Jack issued an order in the silica Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) calling into question the reliability of medical evidence provided by certain doctors and medical screening facilities. Since that time a number of asbestos settlement trusts have determined that they will no longer accept medical evidence solely from such doctors and medical screening facilities.

Based on all of the issues surrounding the doctors and medical screening facilities in question, the Shook & Fletcher Asbestos Settlement Trust (the "Trust"), effective immediately and until further notice, the Trust will no longer accept medical evidence from the following doctors and medical screening facilities:

As of October 1, 2005, unless a claim has been approved for payment as of such date, any claim filed solely with medical evidence provided by one of the above listed doctors or medical screening facilities will be deemed deficient and shall receive a notice to that effect. Any such claimants shall have the opportunity to cure the deficiency by providing the Trust with additional credible medical evidence sufficient to support such claim.
